Class, Instructor Introduction

PURPOSE OF CLASS

• To strategize as a group how more believers can prepare and share their testimonies with a world that is starving for hope.



NOT-SO-HIDDEN AGENDA

• That two or more individuals from this class express their desire to prepare and share their testimony for the first time.



TESTIMONIES: APPRECIATED AND PASSED ON

• In 2014, Charles was led by the Lord to search church websites for testimonies. Shockingly, less than 3% of over 2,000 church websites visited, across multiple states and denominations, even made mention of the word "testimony" or of the more popular alternative "story". Less than 1% published a testimony. Many pastors enthusiastically encouraged Charles to move forward with confidence in his mission to encourage believers to prepare and share their testimonies. However, those same pastors passed on the notion that people in their church would get involved in testimony sharing. In a world where millions of broken people are searching for hope, asking if Jesus really does change lives, the church is reluctant to give evidence. The purpose of this course to explore why that may be and how that can be changed.
